SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

Focus Banish Phosphate Remover is an effective chemical agent used to remove phosphate contamination in swimming pool water.

Phosphates are generally introduced into pool water through animal contamination and common garden fertilizers used around the home. They are an excellent food source for algae, allowing it to grow with strong resistance to conventional algae treatments. Difficulty in controlling an algae infestation could indicate the presence of phosphates in pool water.

Note: Pool water should be tested for phosphates before Focus Banish Phosphate Remover is applied.

Removal of phosphates from pool water enhances the effectiveness of sanitation chemicals and the maintenance of quality pool water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For best performance shake well to ensure contents are fully mixed before each use.

Check filter pressure and if high, clean or backwash filter

Test pool water and ensure ph is between 7.2-7.6 and Total Alkalinity is between 80-120. Adjust accordingly

Pre-mix dosage from chart above into a bucket of water.

With pump running, add solution slowly through skimmer box and circulate for two hours before allowing swimmers to enter pool.

Phosphates will be removed by filtration.

Monitor filter pressure and clean or backwash as required.

SPILLS/LEAKS

Wear full protective equipment. Contain with earth or sand. Collect and place into a suitably labeled container for disposal. Wash down the area with large quantities of water. Refer to Material Safety Data Sheet for further information.

STORAGE & HANDLING

Store in the closed original container in a cool, dry place. DO NOT store in direct sunlight. Store away from other chemicals and food. DO NOT mix with other chemicals. Dispose of container by triple rinsing, adding rinsings to pool, and wrap container in paper disposing in garbage bin.

WARNING

Irritant to skin and eyes.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS

Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wear eye protection when mixing. Wash hands after use.

FIRST AID

If poisoning occurs, contact a doctor of Poisons Information Centre. (Australia: 131 126 New Zealand: 0800 764 766). If in eyes, hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water. Continue flushing until advised by the Poison Information Centre or a doctor, or for at least 15 minutes. If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. If inhaled, remove from contaminated area. Apply artificial respiration if not breathing.
